

Annual Organ Dedication Anniversary Recital: Damin Spritzer May 4, 2025 at 3:00 pm

The Area Chair and Associate Professor of Organ, Dr. Damin Spritzer has been with the University of Oklahoma since 2014. She continues to work with the Cathedral Church of Saint Matthew in Dallas as Artist-in-Residence for Cathedral Arts and is active in the Dallas and Oklahoma City Chapters of the American Guild of Organists. She received her doctorate from the University of North Texas, her Master of Music from the Eastman School of Music, and her Bachelor of Music from the Oberlin Conservatory of Music.

She has performed at historic churches and instruments across the world, including a collaboration with Aaron David Miller at the Walt Disney Concert Hall in Los Angeles. She has been honored to contribute to convention performances and lectures at the 2013 Regional AGO Convention in Austin, the 2018 AGO National Convention in Kansas City, the 2019 Regional AGO Convention in Denver, and the 2019 Organ Historical Society Conference in Dallas. 2022/23 performances included venues in the United States as well as in Germany, Belgium, and England.
